EUROPEAN OPEN CUP OF GRAPPLING

REGULATIONS 04/04/2015

I. OBJECTIVE AND TASKS

To promote grappling.
To improve athletes' grappling skills.

II. PLACE AND TIME OF THE COMPETITION

The competition begins on 4 April 2015 at 11 a. m. in Kaunas Sports Hall. Address: Perkūno al. 5, Kaunas, Lithuania (LTU).

3 April. Arrival of the participants, registration–weigh-in from 6 p. m. to 7 p. m. at the hotel "MAGNUS" Vytauto pr. 25, LT-44352 Kaunas, Lithuania.

4 April. Arrival of the participants, registration–weight-in from 9 a. m. in Kaunas Sports Hall. Address: Perkūno al. 5, Kaunas, Lithuania (LTU).

The athletes must provide a valid participant's licence-registration card and passport (National Identity Card, which indicates nationality and date of birth).

The tournament begins on 4 April at 11 a. m.
